New South Wales Tours 2026

5 Days Merimbula – Sapphire Coast \$1,195 ppts

This tour travels to Merimbula staying 4 nights – the most popular holiday destination located on the scenic New South Wales Sapphire Coast. Experience magnificent coastal scenery and step back in time to visit the regions historic towns and villages. Highlights inc. Short Point – Tathra – Bega – Central Tilba – Bermagui – Boydtown – morning cruise around Twofold Bay aboard “Sapphire Coast Adventure Cruises”

6 Days Broken Hill – “The Accessible Outback” \$1,695 ppts

This six day tour travels through North West Victoria staying overnight in Mildura and then into New South Wales to Broken Hill for 3 nights. We visit Broken Hill’s main attractions inc. Whites Mining Museum – Silver City Mint & Art Centre – Pro Hart & Jack Absalom’s Galleries – Living Desert/Sculpture Sight – Royal Flying Doctor Service and Silverton. Our return journey travels back to Mildura (overnight) to enjoy a Murray River Paddlesteamer Cruise.

6 Days Batemans Bay – Eurobodalla Coast Tour \$1,595 ppts

This six day tour travels via North East Victoria to Albury overnight. We then travel through Canberra to Batemans Bay staying three nights. We explore Batemans Bay and the Eurobodalla Coast including Mogo Zoo – Nelligen – Ulladulla – Mollymook and spectacular dolphin watch cruise @ Jervis Bay. Our return journey travels along the New South Wales Sapphire Coast via Narooma – Merimbula – Eden and East Gippsland staying overnight in Lakes Entrance.

5 Days Canberra “Floriade” Tour \$1,375 ppts

This tour travels into North East Victoria to Albury overnight. We then travel north along the Hume Highway and Barton Highway to Canberra for three nights. Highlights inc.
